## IPO & Listing Update:

- Successfully listed on the **Metropolitan Stock Exchange (MSEI) on January 19, 2024, under the symbol SELECTRIC (ISIN: INE155D01018).**
- Listing followed SEBI/SAT order compliance, resolving a 7-year dispute by facilitating share buybacks for minority shareholders.
- **Post-listing ownership:** Promoters (74.29%), Public (25.71%), IEPF (0.34%).
